FINANCIAL REPORT

PATROL SERVICE – Mike Moradian

Mike reported that over 300 residents / households are currently signed up for patrol service, including 33 businesses. Our goal is 700-800 for complete 24 hour patrol service. We are currently able to fund 10-12 hours of patrol per day. Mike is also working with businesses to establish sponsorships to help get some of the costs covered.

Al’s Security is working in collaboration with Modesto Police Department to put together a protocol book (Standard Operating Procedures handbook) to have in the patrol car. Will also have a database, including pictures of suspicious persons.

MORAN ESTATES PARK – Mike Moradian

Just received an opportunity via City of Modesto to apply for a grant through KABOOM! to build a new playground at Moran Estates Park:

- \$ 50,000 – KABOOM grant for play equipment
- \$ 10,000 – matching funds from City of Modesto

Will need approximately 150+ people to volunteer on a specific day to work “hands-on” to build the park. Collins Electric and Stanislaus Implement have offered services for grating.
